The Board had a conversation with Tom Sobeck, CEO, Presque Isle Electric Power & Gas, regarding shared services.

The cooperative is no longer receiving Renewable Energy Credits and will need to go the open market to purchase them. The Board has authorized the manager to buy up to 5 years into the future, on motion by Hodges and seconded by Heikkinen, on voice vote, motion passed, all ayes. Wolverine Power Cooperative will help secure those credits.

The Board was updated on the status of the PPP funds forgiveness.

A line extension to Point Abbaye was discussed.

On motion by Gasperich and seconded by Rajala, on voice vote, motion passed, all ayes, to donate \$300.00 to the family of the Great Lakes lineman that passed away on the job.

There being no further business to come before the Board, President Koski adjourned the meeting at 12:35 p.m..
